

Jeremiah Grants Guidelines

The purposes of the grants will be twofold:

- (1) to stimulate and initiate ongoing congregational reflection on the significance of contemporary scientific and technological development for the worship, education and mission of the local congregation;
- (2) to recruit a minimum of five new PASTCF members per grant.

All members of PASTCF are eligible to apply for a grant in the name of their congregation. The grant will be awarded to the applicant's congregation for administration. Grant applications must contain the following elements:

- (a) A clear and detailed description of the project to be undertaken. Projects could include a series of lectures, an ongoing congregational seminar, an activity related to worship, congregational education, or mission.
- (b) A clear indication of the congregation's commitment to the project. This could be in the form of an endorsement by the session or pastoral leadership.
- (c) Contact information for the person submitting the proposal and a person who will be designated by the session or pastoral leadership to serve as liaison to PASTCF.
- (d) A clear description of how the project will be continued, or its accomplishments built upon, beyond the period of the grant.
- (e) A detailed budget for the project indicating any additional support from non-PASTCF sources that will be used in the project.
